## Bilateral Framework for Community Participation

Create and sustain a permanent platform/framework for the communities most affected by criminal justice policy to voice perspectives and inform/influence policy and practice.

## System Process and Data Transparency

Ensure that criminal justice system processes and data on system functioning and performance are understandable and easily accessible to community stakeholders and the public.

## Policing Reform

Ensure that policing within Salt Lake County is fair and effective, driven by community-engaged policies and practice, comprehensive community safety metrics, and guided by the values of stewardship, transparency, and accountability.

## Address and Account for Bias

Address conscious and unconscious systemic bias against marginalized identifies within criminal justice processes and entities. Develop and implement policies that account for the existence of bias.

## Youth and Young Adults

Address the experience of youth and young adults in their interactions with law enforcement and other justice system entities both in the community and within formal system settings, ensuring that those interactions are harm reducing, supportive of positive development, and are aligned with the unique developmental needs of youth and young adults.

## Comprehensive Community Safety

In collaboration with CODA Subcommittees on Economic Opportunity, Health, and Housing, address the inequities that contribute to differential community safety outcomes and the need to make appropriate investments in activities that support comprehensive community safety.
